WHAT IS HEALTH DATA?

Health data are information related to health, such as:

- Diagnoses
- Test results
- Treatments
- Hospital stays
- Health registries
- Research data
- Digital health tools...



UNLOCKING THE POTENTIAL OF HEALTH DATA

- * Support research to improve treatments
- * Guide better public health policy making and regulation
- * Enable innovation in healthcare

This is called secondary use: reusing health data to advance research, innovation, and healthcare decisions.



THE PROBLEM: DATA QUALITY VARIES ACROSS DATA SOURCES & DATA HOLDERS

- Missing or biased information
- Errors in records
- Inconsistencies over time
- Differences across hospitals and systems

Low-quality data can limit research and produce unreliable results.
